Thank you to all for your support and the support you give to the OES Home!

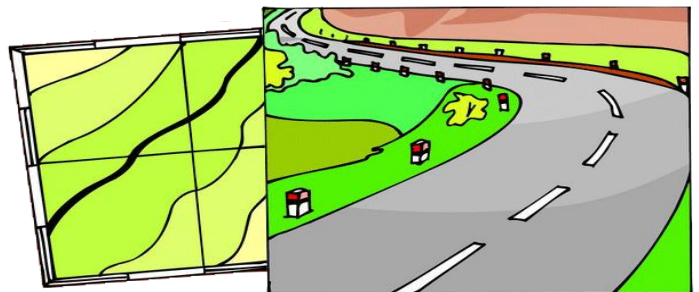
